[At least **Three (3) \$1,000 scholarships** will be awarded by the Detroit Western High School Alumni Association ("DWHSAA").]

### Scholarship Eligibility & Requirements

- 1. All Western International High School seniors may apply for the 2021 DWHSAA scholarships. Dependents of Western International High School's staff are not eligible to apply.
- 2. Applications must be typed and applicants must submit a typewritten, double-spaced essay of between 250 to 500 words.
- Return Applications and documentation to: DWHSAA, c/o Ralph Brighton, 27517 Dover Ave., Livonia, Michigan 48150 before Friday, May 14, 2021. Include with your Application a copy of the college, university or technical school's Acceptance letter where you plan to attend.

#### **Finalists**

All Applications will be verified for accuracy. Factors considered will be judged as a whole, leading to the choices of at least three well-rounded recipients. Scholarship recipients will be chosen based on the information submitted and without regard to income, race, color, religion, national origin, sex, handicap, or familial status. Scholarship finalists will be announced at graduation and Scholarship award checks presented to each recipient.

### Factors Considered

- Grade point average.
- Achievement, ability and honor courses completed.
- Extracurricular involvement in school, community, religious or charitable organizations.
- Typewritten essay.
- Employment history, if applicable.
- Interview.

### Scholarship Selection Committee

The Scholarship Selection Committee ("SSC") will be chosen by the Board of Directors of the DWHSAA and their decisions will be final. After the Scholarship Applications have been evaluated by the SSC, the finalists will be announced at graduation. We appreciate your interest in the Alumni Association Scholarship and will notify non-scholarship applicants by letter following graduation.
